- China has overtaken the U.S. as the world's No. 1 auto market.




Becoming more dependent on foreign oil (53.1%→64.5%)


Power generation by source (US, EU, and China)



Increasing competition in home electronics




GDP per capita by city

- Problem of bride-trafficking


